

**Dr Ioannis Voskos** is a post-doctoral researcher specialised in Cypriot and Aegean Prehistory. He holds a BA degree in Archaeology and Art History and a PhD (Thesis title: “Socio-Economic Dimensions of Storage in Cyprus during the Late Neolithic and Chalcolithic Periods”) from the Faculty of History and Archaeology of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (UoA) and an MPhil in Mediterranean Archaeology from the University of Glasgow. He participated in several excavations and surface surveys in Greece and Cyprus and he has studied and published archaeological material from Cyprus, Kefalonia and other areas. He has also participated in several Conferences and Workshops presenting relevant archaeological work. He is currently teaching in post-graduate seminars of the UoA and he is also working as a developer of teaching material and as a tutor in a number of e-learning courses (Cypriot Prehistory, Minoan iconography etc.) at the UoA. His research interests revolve around Cypriot and Aegean Prehistory, post-colonial and island archaeology, population mobility/entanglements, socio-economic evolution and change, cultural/social identities, prehistoric economy etc.
